1. **ENTRIES CLOSE AT 4:30 P.M. WEDNESDAY, JULY 26, 2017.** An entry fee of \$10.00 will be charged per entry, except in the Championship classes. Stalls \$9.00 per head, and Exhibitor fee \$8.00. Stall rent, Exhibitor ticket, and entry fee must be paid for when entries are made. Stall rent will be charged for all animals. No refunds. **OPEN CLASS DAIRY CATTLE JUDGED ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 2, 2017 AT 8:00 A.M.**
2. An exhibitor will be allowed only two entries in one class.
3. Satisfactory proof of the breeding of each animal must be produced.
4. All stock must be on grounds by Tuesday, August 1, 2017 at 8:00 a.m. unless delayed by another fair and delay approved by the Secretary of both fairs. Cattle released after shown.
5. All entries in this department are subject to the General Rules.
6. Heifers that have freshened, show in 2 year-old classes.
7. All entries must be stated, no blanket entries.
8. Definitions: Spring heifer calf born March 1, 2017 or later; Winter heifer calf born December 1, 2016-February 28, 2017; Fall heifer calf born September 1, 2016-November30, 2016; Summer yearling born June 1, 2016-August 31, 2016; Spring yearling born March 1, 2016-May 31, 2016; Winter yearling born December 1, 2015-February 28, 2016; Fall yearling born September 1, 2015-November 30, 2016. Cow, 2 years born September 1, 2014-August 31, 2015; Cow, 3-4 years born September 1, 2012- August 31, 2014; Cow 5 years and over born before September 1, 2012.
9. The Fair Association reserves the right to refuse any entry; In the event available space is exhausted.

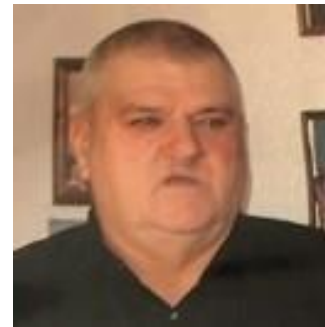
