COUNTY YOUTH ART PROGRAM

New to Logan County Fair in 2018!

PROGRAM IS SEPARATE FROM THE FINE ARTS DEPARTMENT AND WAS COMPLETED THROUGH THE COUNTY SCHOOLS. To submit additional drawings please refer to the Fine Arts Department.

All Logan County students that are in grades Kindergarten, First and Second at the end of the school year were invited to participate in this program at their school. Each student was asked to submit **ONE** drawing to the program, **no entry fee or exhibitor's fee required. No sign-up is needed, students' participated through school program this spring.**

1. The drawings are limited to two categories: **Crayon or Pencil**. The administrators at each of the county schools had the option to choose one or both categories for their students.
2. The two categories are divided into the three class groups. First through fifth place ribbons will be awarded in the six groups. Each participant will receive a coupon for a sweet treat from a local business. **No premiums will be awarded.**
3. All artwork was retrieved from the schools by program sponsors and matted on cardboard and wired for hanging. The students' grade will be printed on the top of the Exhibitors tag for proper classification.
4. The Superintendents will take care of articles on exhibition that are properly mounted and hung, but will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
5. JUDGING WILL BEGIN 9:00 AM ON TUESDAY JULY 31.
6. All artwork will remain on display until Sunday, August 5. The artwork receiving award ribbons will then be displayed at Culver's in Lincoln the week following the fair. *All artwork will be returned to the appropriate schools when classes resume in the fall.*
